Dear Fr. Jerry,

Thank you and the parishioners at Prince of Peace for all of your help over the past five years. We opened the doors to the Blessed Brian Home to our first child, Maheswari, in June of 2012. Since that time we have expanded our mission in several different ways. We now take care of boys as well as the girls. We provide fresh, pure drinking water to the poor villages near the home. And, of course, we feed the indigent through your generosity. When we started the Prince of Peace feeding program we targeted the elderly indigent from the same villages mentioned above by providing a daily hot, nutritious meal. In 2017 we expanded the feeding program to the delivery of food staples and hygiene products to families in need. We are currently delivering weekly to about 25 families enough food for one meal seven days a week.

This program involves all the children at the Blessed Brian Home as they help with putting the “food baskets” together and help in the actual delivery. We use the Blessed Brain Home van to make the deliveries. We hope that the children will gain a better understanding of what Christ asks of us in Matthew chapter 25.

Our goal is to double the number of families from 25 to 50 in 2018. The need in Porumamilla, India is there and we want this feeding aspect of our mission to continue to grow and to serve that need.
